GUIDELINES FOR THE ADMISSION

- A. The admission form is needed to be filled up correctly and neatly, avoid overwriting etc. In such case applicant will have to get a new application form by paying requisite cost of the prospectus.
- B. The application form must be filled by the applicant only.
- C. The application form (supplied with the prospectus) must be submitted either by candidates themselves at office or by registered post accompanied by attested xerox copies of all the certificate asked for. Incomplete application will be rejected.
- D. The authority will not be responsible for any delay in receiving the application forms due to postal delay or any other circumstances.
- E. Application received after expiry of the due date will not be considered. Please post early to avoid delay.
- F. Migration certificate (in original)
- G. Original certificate should be produced at the time of Interview, if not, candidates will not get admission.
- H. Candidate giving false information in the application or in this accompaniments is liable to be discontinued from the training at any time.

PAYMENT OF FEES

- A. Any fee once paid will not be refunded.
- B. Fees once paid cannot be transferred to the Name of any other candidate.
- C. Failure to clear the fees within the stipulated time will cause expulsion of the student from the course giving a written warning.
- D. Registration of examination fees will be charged extra in addition to prescribed fees.
- E. Payment can be made in Cash/DD of which the receipt has to be produced at office.
- F. Fees are renewable from time to time as per instructions from Higher Authority.
- G. Monthly Fees/Installments has to be cleared on or before 10th of every month. In case of late deposit a fine will be levied.

RULES & REGULATIONS

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Students must maintain the discipline of the Academy and should abide by the rules & regulations given below.

a) Candidates shall abide the Rules & Regulations in force as well as those that may be issued by the Academy from time to time.

b) False declaration of qualification by the candidate will disqualify his/her admission to the Academy including appropriate panel action.

c) This prospectus provides all information that you need as a candidate of the courses of the Academy. You are therefore advised to keep this prospectus till you complete your programme. Avoid unnecessary queries about the details already available in this prospectus.

d) Any change in name or address should be intimated to the academy.

e) Changes any or upgradation in syllabus is decision of academy on its own.

f) The admission of any candidate to any program under any scheme is solely academy's decision that cannot be questioned by any individual.

g) Everyone will be issued a photo identity card which should be carried by them at all time while being at the campus. The identity card should compulsorily be carried along to the examination centre as identity proof. Identity card is issued against a fee. If in case of lost, the student can collect from office with a fee.

h) Any misuse of the Academy's property, apparatus, reagents, books or magazines etc. will result in cancellation of the studentship & student responsible will be liable for all damages. In case of breakage or damage of the Academy's property, the accused student must either replace the same or compensate the loss by way of bearing the cost of such equipment as decide by the Authority considering the market price.

i) No drinks are permitted inside the Academy's premises.

j) Student who discontinues her/his classes, without any prior information is liable to be dismissed from the academy.

k) The authority of the academy reserves the right to reject any application or dismiss a student under the ground of indisciplinary attitude found on the part of the student. The academy is authorised to add or alter any rule for smooth running of the academy.

l) If a student discontinues at the middle of the running session and desired to be enrolled again, he/she has to pay the re-admission fees and other charges as per the rules of the academy.

m) Students of the Academy must maintain discipline & decorum in the Academy premises.

n) Students are forbidden to form unions and must not have political affiliations/associations in the Academy campus or outside since, the duration of the course is too short and students are to devote their attention fully in the academic matters. Students associated with such activities will be expelled from the academy without any prior notice.

o) Students facing any problems regarding his/her educations are directed to inform in the Academy office directly by his/her self but not in the form of group or team.

p) Students should attend their classes with proper dress. The dress should be clean, ironed and proportional.

q) All holidays and days of sudden closure of the Academy in case of unavoidable circumstances will be notified on the Notice board as and when required in advance.

r) Students are warned against consumption of any alcoholic drinks drugs and consuming any material which causes intoxication inside the academy premises.

UNIFORM

ATTENDANCE

Students have to attend minimum 90 % of the classes held, failing they may be debarred from appearing in the examination. However, a student may avail leave of absence from the principal on genuine grounds. In such case, he or she has to submit an application with guardian's signature, if fail a fine shall be imposed.
